

## APPROVAL REPORT

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# The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2020

### ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9696, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2020* for City Council's consideration. *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2020* implements City Council's decision to continue to allow for the issuance of residential parking permits to certain multiple-unit dwellings that would have otherwise been rendered ineligible due to changes to the *Zoning Bylaw*.

### RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9696, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2020*.

### BACKGROUND

At its March 23, 2020 Public Hearing Meeting, City Council considered the report of the General Manager, Community Standards, dated February 25, 2020, and resolved in part:

"That the City Solicitor be directed to bring forward an amendment to Bylaw No. 7862 to allow for the issuance of permits as identified in this report".

### DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council's instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9696, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2020* for City Council's consideration.
