BYLAW NO. 9693

The Discounts and Penalties Amendment Bylaw, 2020

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Discounts and Penalties Amendment Bylaw, 2020.*

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend A bylaw of the City of Saskatoon to provide for the payment of taxes and the application of discounts and penalties thereto in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to allow property owners an additional three months (to September 30) to pay their 2020 property tax bill without incurring any penalties.

Bylaw No. 6673 Amended

3. A bylaw of the City of Saskatoon to provide for the payment of taxes and the application of discounts and penalties thereto is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Section 1.2 Amended

- 4. (1) Section 1.2 is amended by renumbering it as subsection 1.2(1).
 - (2) Subsection 1.2(1) is amended by:
 - (a) striking out "All" and substituting "Subject to Subsection (2), all"; and
 - (b) striking out "at the Office of the City Treasurer" and substituting "to Corporate Revenue".
 - (3) Section 1.2 is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (1):
 - "(2) All taxes imposed in the year 2020 shall be paid to Corporate Revenue on or before September 30.".

Section 3.4 Amended

- 5. Section 3.4 is repealed and the following substituted:
 - "3.4 Should any taxes imposed on land and improvements not be paid as provided in Section 1.2, an additional penalty charge of 1.25 per cent per month, compounded monthly until December 31 of that year, shall be imposed upon the unpaid taxes as penalty for default in payment and the penalty charge shall be added to and form part of the taxes.".

6. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
