The Discounts and Penalties Amendment Bylaw, 2020

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9693, *The Discounts and Penalties Amendment Bylaw, 2020* for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw amends *The Discounts and Penalties Bylaw, 1987* in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to allow property owners an additional three months (to September 30) to pay their 2020 property tax bill without incurring any penalties.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9693, *The Discounts and Penalties Amendment Bylaw, 2020.*

At its <u>March 19, 2020 Special Meeting</u>, City Council considered the report of the Chief Financial Officer dated March 19, 2020, and resolved:
