Pedestrian on Street Rules

The Traffic Safety Act states, in part:

"Rules re pedestrians

"(5) No person, other than a pedestrian in charge of an animal, shall walk along that portion of a highway used for vehicular traffic, except close to the edge on his or her left."

Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI)'s 2019-20 Saskatchewan Driver's Handbook states, in part:

"3.21 Pedestrians

Pedestrians walking along a road should walk on the left shoulder, facing oncoming traffic."
