

## Roles in the Development Application Process

The following describes the roles of participants in the Engagement Process.

Applicant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provides all information pertinent to the application</li> <li>• Attend public information meetings</li> </ul>
Development Review Planning and Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepares notification, signage and advertising</li> <li>• Receives and evaluates feedback received</li> <li>• Plans and facilitates consultation activities</li> <li>• Provides feedback to City Council</li> </ul>
Other Civic Divisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provides technical expertise and assistance</li> <li>• Participates in consultation activities when required</li> </ul>
Public and other Stakeholders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provides feedback and attend public information meetings</li> </ul>
Community associations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Distributes information on the proposal or on consultation events.</li> <li>• Does not speak on behalf of the neighbourhood</li> </ul>
Ward Councillor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Receives feedback from stakeholders</li> <li>• Participates in consultation activities</li> </ul>
City Council	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Considers feedback received at the Public Hearing</li> </ul>
