# The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020

### ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9705, *The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020* (the “Bylaw”) for City Council’s further consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to amend the rules that apply to the operation of bicycles.

### RECOMMENDATION

That City Council further consider Bylaw No. 9705, *The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020*.

### BACKGROUND

The Bylaw was first presented to City Council at its [May 25, 2020 Regular Business Meeting](#). At this meeting, the Bylaw was given its first reading, and City Council resolved:

“That further consideration of Bylaw No. 9705, The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020 be deferred to the July meeting of City Council and that Administration report back upon consultation with the Business Improvement Districts which high traffic corridors should be restricted within this Bylaw with respect to restricting cycling on sidewalks and that those restrictions be included for consideration of the Bylaw.”

At its [June 29, 2020 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered the report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction Department dated June 29, 2020 and defeated a motion to include restrictions on bicycles riding on sidewalks in identified areas in the Downtown and Riversdale Business Improvement Districts.

### DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instruction, we are pleased to resubmit Bylaw No. 9705, *The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020* for City Council’s further consideration.
