# **BYLAW NO. 9715**

# The Vehicles for Hire Amendment Bylaw, 2020

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

### **Short Title**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Vehicles for Hire Amendment Bylaw*, 2020.

## **Purpose**

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Vehicles for Hire Bylaw, 2019* to suspend some of the operating requirements for enterprise taxi licences during a public emergency period.

## Bylaw No. 9651 Amended

3. The Vehicles for Hire Bylaw, 2019 is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

#### **Section 2 Amended**

- 4. Section 2 is amended by adding the following after clause (r):
  - "(r.1) "public emergency period" means the period during which an order of the chief medical health officer issued pursuant to subsection 2-59.1(2) of *The Saskatchewan Employment Act*, or an emergency declaration ordered pursuant to *The Emergency Planning Act*, is in force;".

#### **Section 26 Amended**

5. Clause 26(4)(e) is amended by striking out "and medical leave" and substituting ", medical leave and any public emergency period".

#### Section 30 Amended

- 6. Subsection 30(4) is repealed and the following substituted:
  - "(4) The licensee may, without surrendering the enterprise taxi licence to the City pursuant to clause (3)(a):
    - (a) take up to a combined total of eight weeks annually for vacation and medical leave, excluding any vacation or medical leave used during a public emergency period; and
    - (b) cease to operate the taxi for a minimum of 40 hours per week during a public emergency period.".

## **Coming into Force**

7. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing, but is retroactive and is deemed to have been in force on and from March 19, 2020.
