2020 Local Government Elections - Mail-in Ballot Procedure

Recommendation of the Committee

- 1. That the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 8191, *The Election Bylaw, 2012*, as outlined in the report of the City Clerk dated July 20, 2020, be approved;
- 2. That the City Solicitor's Office be directed to amend Bylaw No. 8191, *The Election Bylaw*, 2012; and
- 3. That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9717, The Election Amendment Bylaw, 2020.

History

The Governance and Priorities Committee, at its meeting held on July 20, 2020, considered a report of the City Clerk regarding the above.

In order to comply with the requirements of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015,* that a general election bylaw be passed at least 90 days before the general election, the City Solicitor has prepared Bylaw No. 9717, in anticipation of City Council adopting recommendations 1 and 2 above. Your Committee therefore requests consideration of the attached bylaw at this meeting.
