## **BYLAW NOTICE**

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CANNABIS BUSINESS LICENSE BYLAW – BYLAW NO. 9716

Saskatoon City Council will consider a report from the City Solicitor on Monday, August 31, 2020 at 6:00 pm in Council Chambers City Hall (222 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue N), recommending that City Council consider Bylaw No. 9716, *The Cannabis Business License Amendment Bylaw, 2020,* which will:

- Amend subsection 6(1) to reduce the initial license fee for a cannabis production facility and a cannabis retail store from \$20,000 to \$4,500; and
- Change the spelling of "license" to "licence" and reformat the definition section to align with current drafting practices, including the removal of footnotes.
