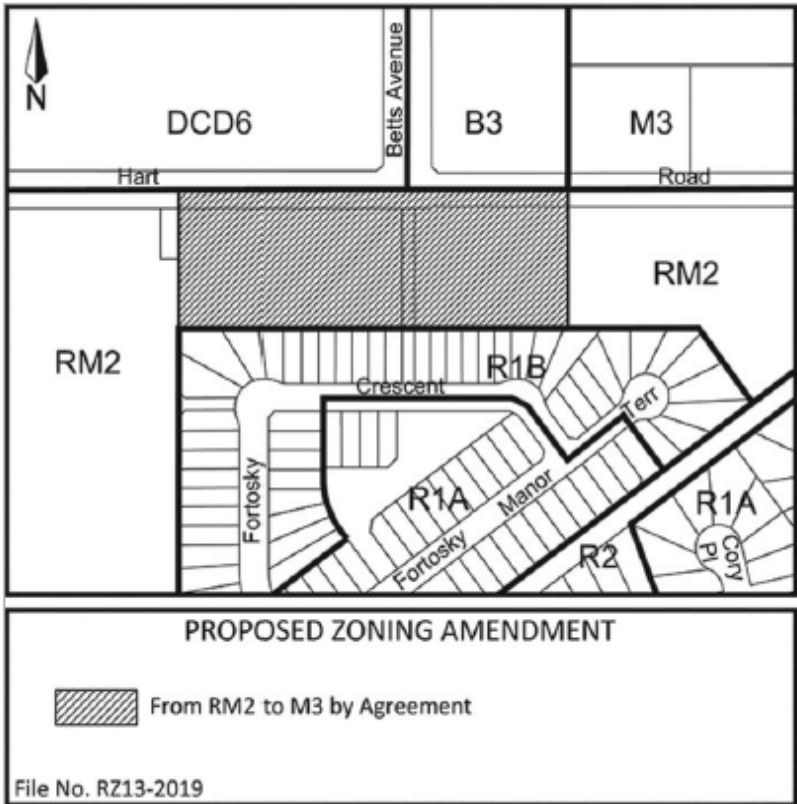


ZONING NOTICE
BLAIRMORE SUBURBAN CENTRE
PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 9721, THE ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2020 (NO. 19)

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the City’s Zoning Bylaw (No. 8770) proposed by Camponi Housing Corporation to rezone 727 and 803 Hart Road, located in the Blairmore Suburban Centre. By way of Bylaw No. 9721, The Zoning Amendment Bylaw, 2020 (No. 19), 727 and 803 Hart Road are proposed to be rezoned from RM2 – Low/Medium Density Multiple-Unit Dwelling District to M3 – General Institutional Service District, subject to a Zoning Agreement.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION – Block AA and Block BB, Plan No. 102177862



REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT – The applicant is proposing to rezone the sites to a M3 – General Institutional Service District, subject to a Zoning Agreement, to provide for the development of a mixed-use development. The proposed development will consist of six three-storey buildings that will provide for a total of 158 residential dwelling units, six dwelling units for special needs housing, a day care, community space, offices and limited commercial and institutional uses. The residential portion of the development will include a mix of one, two and four-bedroom units. The Zoning Agreement will limit the development to the specific proposal.
