RE: SUPENSION OF SATURDAY PAY PARKING REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your consideration shown to businesses where Pay Parking Zones exist.

Everything counts, and all incentives are crucial to helping business generate sales to maintain operations and employment levels.

Should Council proceed with plans to offer free paid parking on Saturdays through the end of April 2021, we would request:

- That the time limitations still be observed and enforced in order to maintain turnover and availability of parking stalls in our District.
- That the BID grant amounts remain as allocated since historically this has been observed.
- The Streetscape Reserve be managed to ensure maintenance and service levels for BID areas continues to improve.
- The funding of the Community Support Officers is reviewed to secure an alternative source of funding other

than the Streetscape Reserve.

- The motion from Councillor Iwanchuk to secure funding for the Streetscape Master Plan for 20th to 22nd Streets; Idylwyld Drive to Avenue D is secured for 2021 budgeting through the Streetscape Reserve funds.
