That the City Clerk be requested to update Council Policy No. C03-027, Borrowing for Capital Projects, as detailed in the report of the Chief Financial Officer dated November 30, 2020, that clarifies that borrowing may be done internally through an investment of its own available cash balances similar to investments the City makes externally.
