[CK 7830-1]**

A letter from Don Meister, dated November 10, 2020 was provided.

Don Meister addressed the concern of landfill waste material, noting that anything of an organic nature should not go into the landfill. He suggested pyrolysis as a method to process waste material where material is thermally decomposed into combustible gases and charcoal, further noting that a pyrolysis processor could be used as a system to reduce landfill waste material.
