I am opposed to the proposed bylaw of conversion therapy for many reasons. I will briefly relay a few.

First I do not believe a municipal council should be involved in these types of issues.

This bylaw is very broad making its boundaries unclear as to how far this bylaw can interfere with the Canadian Charter of Rights: Freedom of Speech, Freedom of Religion, Freedom of Conscience.

I have great concern that this bylaw has the potential to step in the homes of families and muzzle the mouths of parents whose role it is to guide and counsel their own children through the challenges of life - and gender confusion is included as one of them.

It is equally as cruel to leave a young child to flounder through this alone because of the threat of breaking a bylaw that carries a ridiculously crippling fine. Children need guidance and it needs to come from the ones who love them - their parents.
