The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2021

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9738, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2021* (the "Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to amend *The Residential Parking Program Bylaw, 1999* to make various changes to the parking program.

RECOMMENDATION

At its May 25, 2020 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered the report of the General Manager, Community Services dated May 4, 2020 and resolved:

That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate amendments to Bylaw No. 7862, The Residential Parking Program Bylaw, 1999; and

That the City Clerk be requested to repeal Policy C07-014, Residential Parking Permit Program."
