# **Conversion Therapy - The Prohibited Businesses Bylaw,** 2021

#### **ISSUE**

This report submits Bylaw No. 9747, *The Prohibited Businesses Bylaw, 2021* (the "Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to prohibit the business of conversion therapy within the City of Saskatoon.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9747, The Prohibited Businesses Bylaw, 2021.

#### **BACKGROUND**

At its <u>April 27, 2020 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered the report of the City Solicitor dated April 20, 2020 and resolved in part:

That a bylaw be drafted to prohibit conversion therapy as a business in Saskatoon.

At its <u>January 25, 2021 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered the report of the City Solicitor dated January 18, 2021, attached to which was a draft *Prohibited Businesses Bylaw, 2021*, and resolved:

That the City Solicitor be instructed to bring back the Prohibited Businesses Bylaw, removing Section D, to City Council for its consideration.

#### **DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS**

In accordance with City Council's instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9747, *The Prohibited Businesses Bylaw*, *2021* for City Council's consideration.
