BYLAW NO. 9749

The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw, 2021

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw*, 2021.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020* to include the current process to be followed for unclaimed bicycles.

Bylaw No. 9705 Amended

3. The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020 is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

New Section 15.1

4. The following section is added after section 15:

"Unclaimed Bicycles

- 15.1 (1) Every bicycle that is found by, delivered to or recovered by the Saskatoon Police Service must be kept by the Saskatoon Police Service for at least 90 days, unless it is claimed earlier by the owner.
 - (2) Any bicycle which remains unclaimed after 90 days may be sold at a public auction.
 - (3) In the event of a sale:
 - notice of the sale must be advertised publicly online for at least two successive weeks just prior to the date of the sale; and
 - (b) the notice must include the make and model of each bicycle to be sold.

- (4) A person may claim a bicycle at any time up to 12:00 noon on the date of the sale if the person establishes ownership of the bicycle to the satisfaction of the Saskatoon Police Service.
- (5) The profits of the sale form part of the general revenues of the Saskatoon Police Service.
- (6) The Unclaimed Personal Property Bylaw, 2003 does not apply to bicycles to which this section applies.".

Coming into Force

5. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
