The family of Late Fred Sasakamoose has been requested and have approved a commemorative statue of Fred Sasakamoose to be placed at the Sasktel Centre. The Family will approve all final design of the Statue and are communicating with the interested parties, that being Battleford Agency Tribal Chiefs (BATC), Saskatoon Tribal Council (STC) and Synergy 8.

There has been a Fred Sasakamoose Statue Committee that we will be discussing and planning logistics with that will include the Sasktel Centre management.

We have selected the date of May 18th to formally announce the proposed Statue in addition to other items.

May 18th, 2021 will be a Covid friendly press release that will include the family components:

1. Province of Saskatchewan Proclamation for May 18th to be Fred Sasakamoose Day. That has been approved and signed off by the appropriate Ministry. This proclamation can be renewed annually if required.

2. The City of Saskatoon to declare May 18th as Fred Sasakamoose Day. This is for the City Council to consider and this is the Sasakamoose Family Request. This can also be reviewed annually if required.

3. The release of Fred Sasakamoose memoir "Call Me Indian" is available to the public on May 18th, 2021. The long awaited account of Fred Sasakamoose life.

4. The announcement of the proposed Fred Sasakamoose Statue at Sasktel Centre.

We are looking forward to this day and are hoping the City of Saskatoon can support in this celebration by approving the Statue and declaring May 18th Fred Sasakamoose Day.
