Comments

The Riversdale Business Improvement District would prefer that E-scooters be pursued provided that they are properly docked and not left on sidewalks when not in use. It is to allow pedestrians and those visually impaired a reasonable expectation that the sidewalk will not be impeded by careless discard of the scooters in high pedestrian areas.

Concern has also been raised and needs to be addressed about allowing them on sidewalks in commercial areas. Without requirements for governed speed and audible warning devices to alert pedestrians, there is significant apprehension about competing use of sidewalks with bicycles, E-scooters, and E-bikes where pedestrians are.
