

## Status of Solid Waste Reduction and Diversion Plan Actions

Each action listed in the Plan will be brought forward for City Council's consideration and budget approvals to move through the stages of development, implementation, and operations.

- Development includes research, engagement, and pilots and typically is completed using capital funding. The result is a decision report outlining options, implications, and the administration's recommendation.
- Implementation involves putting into place all the components necessary for a successful service or program following approval and funding. The activities will vary depending on the specific action. Implementation typically utilizes capital funding with a transition plan to operating funding.
- Operations is the sustainment and ongoing delivery of the program to meet expected service levels as well as result evaluation and continuous improvement. Once operational, budget adjustments are made to reflect the actual program cost. Corporate work alignment, project portfolio assessment and external capital funding opportunities for implementation of the Plan's actions will be reviewed regularly.

The following table outlines the stage for each action that has been completed or is in progress for 2020 and 2021. It also shows the proposed phasing of stages for 2022 to 2025.
