ISSUE

The 2020-2021 membership for the Federation of Canadian Municipalities [FCM] expired March 31, 2021. The membership renewal invoice is being submitted to City Council for approval.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Federation of Canadian Municipalities 2021-2022 membership fees, in the amount of \$52,642.12, including GST, be paid.

BACKGROUND

An invoice from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities regarding the 2021-2022 membership fees was received. The invoice includes the base fee and per capita dues calculated at \$52,642.12, including GST.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

The City of Saskatoon has traditionally been a member of FCM and nominates members of City Council for the FCM Board of Directors and standing committees. Elections for the FCM National Board of Directors take place at the annual FCM Conference scheduled to be held in June 2021. In order for members to be eligible to vote in the elections, the membership fee is required to be paid.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There is adequate annual budget to cover the membership fees.
