# **Updated Parking Revenue Distribution Formula**

#### **ISSUE**

This report submits Bylaw No. 9769, *The Capital Reserve Amendment Bylaw, 2021* (the "Bylaw") and amendments to Council Policy C03-003, the *Reserves for Future Expenditures* policy, for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw and policy amendments implement City Council's decision to amend how the Parking Capital Reserve is funded.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9769, *The Capital Reserve Amendment Bylaw*, 2021.
- 2. That City Council instruct the City Clerk to make the necessary amendments to Council Policy C03-003, the *Reserves for Future Expenditures* policy.

## **BACKGROUND**

At its <u>April 26, 2021 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered the report of the General Manager of Community Services dated April 12, 2021 and resolved in part:

That the City Solicitor's Office be requested to bring forward amendments to relevant policies and bylaws, including Bylaw No. 6774, Capital Reserve Bylaw, 1993.

## **DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS**

In accordance with City Council's instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9769, *The Capital Reserve Amendment Bylaw, 2021* for City Council's consideration.

Council Policy C03-003, the *Reserves for Future Expenditures* policy, is to be amended by striking out the following from section 46.2:

This Reserve shall be funded annually in the amount of \$30,000 from the City's parking meter revenues. This amount is to be directed towards housing projects in the downtown.
