

Assessed Risk of Epidemic Transmission

The assessed risk of epidemic transmission is determined by combining COVID-19 monitoring indicators and local public health knowledge of epidemiological and social risk factors. Surveillance indicators and thresholds for epidemic spread, public health capacity, and health care system capacity, along with extensive understanding of local transmission, signal when public health authorities need to consider changes to existing public health orders and measures, and local actions and activities to control transmission.

Saskatoon Area: COVID transmission is controlled, but there is a risk of community transmission.
