

BYLAW NO. 9773

The Tag Days Bylaw, 2021

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Tag Days Bylaw, 2021*.

Definitions

2. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) “**charitable purpose**” means any actual or purported benevolent, philanthropic, patriotic, artistic, athletic, recreational or civic purpose or any purpose that has as its object the promotion or provision of a public service;
 - (b) “**organization**” means a person or association of persons;
 - (c) “**public place**” means any property owned by the City, leased by the City or under the jurisdiction and control of the City and includes a street;
 - (d) “**solicit**” means:
 - (i) to canvass for, solicit or collect money, goods or financial assistance of any kind for a charitable purpose; or
 - (i) to sell or offer to sell any goods or services or other thing of value or purported value for a charitable purpose;
 - (e) “**street**” means street as defined in *The Traffic Bylaw*;
 - (f) “**tag day**” means a day set aside for an organization to solicit donations from the public for a charitable purpose.

Purpose

3. The purpose of this Bylaw is to prohibit soliciting in public places without permission from the City.

Soliciting Prohibited

- 4. No organization shall solicit in any public place without permission from the City to conduct a tag day.

Offence

- 5. Any organization that contravenes this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$500.00 for each day that the offence continues.

Bylaw No. 5734 Repealed

- 6. A bylaw of The City of Saskatoon to regulate and control persons and organizations soliciting upon the public streets of the City of Saskatoon is repealed.

Coming Into Force

- 7. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
