Thank you for submitting an application for inclusion in Saskatoon's Veteran Parking Program.

Applicants are required to present documentation supporting their having served overseas in one or more of the following:

- a) Canadian Forces, Allied Forces, Merchant Navy or Ferry Command in:
  - 1) World War I
  - 2) World War II
  - 3) Korean War
  - 4) Afghanistan
- d) United Nations Peacekeeper

In addition, proof of vehicle registration demonstrating that the applicant has received a veteran plate from Saskatchewan government insurance and resides within a 30 kilometer radius of Saskatoon is also required.

Based on the program criteria and the information that you submitted with your application, it has been determined that you do not qualify to participate.

The status of your application will be reviewed if you provide additional documentation that would satisfy the above referenced program criteria.
