What is the 2022 and 2023 Estimated Financial Implications for a Single Family Residential Property assessed at \$240,000? I could not find the average assessed values by Wards or Neighbourhoods. I did find the average sale price of a single family dwelling in 2019 in Ward 2 was \$240,204. The

average sale price in Confed Park was \$240,882 and in Pacific Heights was \$242,090.

My understanding is that all implementation costs would also be passed on through the utility rate. This report does not indicate that this is a known cost. Does that mean that the estimated rates for single family households will actually be higher than indicated, once implementation costs are considered?
