

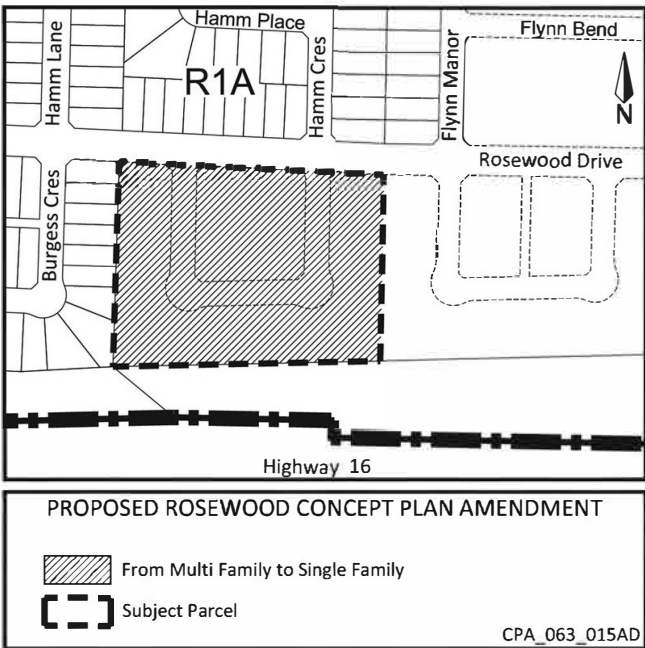
NEIGHBOURHOOD CONCEPT PLAN NOTICE
ROSEWOOD NEIGHBOURHOOD CONCEPT PLAN – PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the Rosewood Neighbourhood Concept Plan proposed by Boychuk Investments Ltd. The proposed amendment would provide for a change in the land use for sites located adjacent to Rosewood Drive as shown on the map below from ‘Multi Family’ to ‘Single Family’. The proposed amendment would also provide for the addition of a local road to service the subject sites.

REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT – The proposed Rosewood Neighbourhood Concept Plan amendment, in conjunction with a Zoning Bylaw amendment, would provide for the future subdivision and development of the subject lands for One and Two-Unit Dwellings and related community uses. The sites are currently identified for the development of a Dwelling Group on the Rosewood Neighbourhood Concept Plan.
