

APPROVAL REPORT

The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9793, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021* (the “Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to provide preference to Indigenous applicants in filling one of four member-at-large positions on the Board of Police Commissioners.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9793, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021*.

BACKGROUND

At its [October 25, 2021 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council resolved:

That the City Solicitor be instructed to amend Bylaw No. 7531, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Bylaw* in accordance with Option 2 as outlined in the report of the City Solicitor dated October 18, 2021, to indicate that preference for one member-at-large position on the Board be given to a qualified candidate from the Indigenous community.
