The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9793, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021* (the "Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to provide preference to Indigenous applicants in filling one of four member-at-large positions on the Board of Police Commissioners.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9793, The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2021.

BACKGROUND

At its October 25, 2021 Regular Business Meeting, City Council resolved:

That the City Solicitor be instructed to amend Bylaw No. 7531, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Bylaw* in accordance with Option 2 as outlined in the report of the City Solicitor dated October 18, 2021, to indicate that preference for one member-at-large position on the Board be given to a qualified candidate from the Indigenous community.
