**BYLAW NOTICE**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CANNABIS BUSINESS LICENSE BYLAW– BYLAW NO. 9792**

Saskatoon City Council will consider a report from the City Solicitor on **Monday, December 20, 2021 at 6:00 pm in Council Chambers City Hall (222 3rd Avenue N)**, recommending that City Council consider Bylaw No. 9792, The Cannabis Business License Amendment Bylaw, 2021, which will:

- Amend the business license application fee for a new cannabis related business from \$4,500 to \$500; and
- Amend the change of location fee for a cannabis related business from \$125 to \$500.
