2020

- Mar 11 - Pandemic is declared
- Mar 20 - Rear door boarding and fare suspension
 - COVID safety Mobile Data Terminal buttons added
- Jun 8 - Front door boarding and fare collection resumes
 - Vinyl operator panels installed
- Aug 31 - City Council resolves that masks are required on Transit effective September 1**
- Sep 1 - Disposable masks available on all buses for riders for 2 weeks
 - External announcements when the doors open
- Nov 6 - Government of Saskatchewan issues Public Health Order mandating mask use in all indoor spaces in Saskatoon, including transit.**
- Nov 19 - Government of Saskatchewan issues Public Health Order mandating mask use in all indoor spaces in Saskatchewan, including transit.**

2021

- Jul 11 - All Public Health Orders removed**
- Aug 30 - City Council resolves that masks are required on Transit effective September 1**
- Sep 1 - Disposable masks available on all buses for riders for 2 weeks
 - External announcements when the doors open
- Sep 17 - Government of Saskatchewan issues Public Health Order mandating mask use in all indoor spaces, including transit.**
- Oct 4 - Operators required to wear masks behind the vinyl barrier

2022

- Jan 11 - Disposable masks available on all buses for riders
