The Saskatoon Accessibility Advisory Committee, at its meeting held on May 14, 2021, reviewed the terms of reference for the Saskatoon Accessibility Advisory Committee as provided by the Leadership Team Governance Subcommittee.

The Committee respectfully requests the following revisions to the terms of reference:

A new category of membership under **Composition** called *Lived Experience Group Representatives* 

Lived experience groups are predominantly organized and directed by disabled people. Typically, disabled people form most of the membership of these groups. The primary goal of these groups is to provide the mean and advocacy for disabled people to represent their concerns and views directly to governments, businesses, and the public.

The Advisory Committee suggests that the lived experience groups must apply for membership on the Saskatoon Accessibility Committee. Each group shall have one representative and a maximum of five lived experience groups shall have members on the committee.

The Saskatoon Accessibility Advisory Committee respectfully requests that the suggested revision be considered by Governance and Priorities Committee.
