

APPROVAL REPORT

The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9813, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022* (the “Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to expand the Varsity View and City Park Residential Parking Program Zones.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9813, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022*.

BACKGROUND

At its [December 20, 2021 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services dated December 6, 2021 and resolved:

1. That Residential Parking Program zones be expanded, as outlined in the report of the General Manager, Community Services dated December 6, 2021, using existing resources; and
2. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7862, Residential Parking Program, 1999.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

A housekeeping amendment to *The Residential Parking Program Bylaw, 1999* was identified when preparing the Bylaw and is included. The Bylaw will come into effect on March 7, 2022 to allow time for appropriate signage and communication with residents.

In accordance with City Council’s instructions, we are pleased to submit the Bylaw for City Council’s consideration.
