PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO BORROW

City Council will be considering a report from the Administration at a City Council meeting to be held on Monday, March 28, 2022 at 6:00 p.m., via Teleconference, hosted in the Council Chamber, Saskatoon City Hall, recommending:

That City Council authorize the following planned borrowing:

- 1. up to \$9,833,200 for the Property Assessed Clean Energy Financing Program (Capital Project P1956) from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities and internal borrowing (which includes \$2,500,000 in previously approved borrowing and \$7,333,200 in new borrowing);
- 2. an allowable 10% variance on the borrowing requirements for the project identified. Any variance greater than 10% of the borrowing amount identified would require a new public notice.

The Cities Act and The Public Notice Policy Bylaw No.8171 require that City Council give public notice before borrowing money, lending money or guaranteeing the repayment of a loan.
