#### **BYLAW NO. 9830**

# The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Amendment Bylaw, 2022

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

#### **Short Title**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Amendment Bylaw, 2022.* 

#### **Purpose**

- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Bylaw, 2006* to:
  - (a) make changes recommended by the Saskatoon Municipal Review Commission and approved by City Council, including:
    - (i) amending the definition of "campaign expense" to exclude remuneration paid to an official agent;
    - (ii) housekeeping amendments to all schedules to ensure clarity, consistency, and thoroughness;
    - (iii) adding two new schedules, one identifying the appointment of official agent for a candidate for mayor and one identifying the appointment of auditor for a candidate for mayor;
    - (iv) clarifying language regarding the retention of records by candidates when an official agent has been appointed; and
    - (v) amending section 25 to specifically identify provisions of *The Cities Act* relevant to disqualification of a candidate;
  - (b) include a definition of "campaign period";
  - (c) amend subsection 3(2) to permit website development, signs and incidental financial charges required to accept campaign contributions as expenses that may be incurred in advance of the campaign expenses period; and

- (d) make housekeeping amendments and clarify language in response to inquiries received or issues identified by the Returning Officer during the last election period, including:
  - (i) clarifying the definition of "campaign contribution" to include "personal contributions" and defining the same;
  - (ii) clarifying the definition of "campaign expense" to include credit card fees associated with accepting a campaign contribution, expressions of appreciation by candidates after the close of voting on election day and excluding the repayment of a loan excepting interest;
  - (iii) removing the requirement that campaign expenses must be made by cheque;
  - (iv) clarifying that contributors shall be identified by first and last name or organization;
  - (v) clarifying that a candidate's Statutory Declaration must be signed by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public or Commissioner of Oaths; and
  - (vi) adding a Table of Contents for ease of reference.

### Bylaw No. 8491 Amended

3. Bylaw No. 8491, *The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Bylaw, 2006* is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

#### Section 2 Amended

- 4. (1) Clause 2(a) is amended by:
  - (a) striking out "paid" after "money";
  - (b) striking out "given" after "loans" and substituting "or other advances"; and
  - (c) adding "personal contributions and" after ", including".
  - (2) Clause 2(c) is amended by:

- (a) adding "credit card fees associated with accepting campaign contributions, the cost of making expressions of appreciation after the close of voting on election day," after ", including"; and
- (b) adding ", any remuneration paid to an official agent or the repayment of a loan, except for interest" after "audit fees".
- (3) Section 2 is amended by adding the following after clause 2(d):
  - "(d.1) "campaign period" means the period beginning on June 1 of the year immediately preceding a general election and ending on the date of the general election;".
- (4) Section 2 is amended by adding the following after clause 2(n):
  - "(n.1) "personal contributions" means campaign contributions made by a candidate to their campaign from their own funds;".

#### **Section 3 Amended**

- 5. Subsection 3(2) is repealed and replaced with the following:
  - "3(2) Expenses incurred for the preparation of election advertising materials, website development, signs and incidental financial charges required to accept campaign contributions may be incurred prior to the campaign expenses period but must be recorded and disclosed as campaign expenses in accordance with this Bylaw."

#### **Section 3.2 Amended**

- 6. (1) Section 3.2 is amended by adding the following after subsection (2):
  - "(2.01) A candidate for mayor shall, at the same time as they submit their nomination paper, file an Appointment of Official Agent in the form prescribed in Schedule "F" with the Returning Officer.
  - (2.02) If the official agent ceases to act for any reason, the candidate for mayor shall immediately appoint another official agent and file a new Appointment of Official Agent in the form prescribed in Schedule "F" with the Returning Officer.".

- (3) Subclause 3.2(2.1)(c)(v) is amended by striking out "not less than two years after the election" and substituting "the duration of the term of office for which the candidate sought election".
- (4) Subclause 3.2(2.1)(c)(vi) is amended by:
  - (a) striking out "relating to or arising out of the election campaign" and substituting "for campaign expenses"; and
  - (b) striking out "by cheque drawn on" and substituting "from".

#### **Section 5 Amended**

- 7. (1) Clause 5(3)(a) is amended by:
  - (a) striking out "in writing"; and
  - (b) adding "signed by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public or Commissioner of Oaths" after "Schedule "A"".
  - (2) Clause 5(3)(c) is amended by:
    - (a) striking out "in writing"; and
    - (b) adding "first and last" before "name of each contributor" in subclause (i).

#### **Section 6 Amended**

- 8. Section 6 is amended by adding the following after subsection 6(1):
  - "(1.1) A candidate for mayor shall, within one month after election day, file an Appointment of Auditor in the form prescribed in Schedule "G" with the Returning Officer.
  - (1.2) If the auditor ceases to act for any reason, the candidate for mayor shall immediately appoint another auditor and file a new Appointment of Auditor in the form prescribed in Schedule "G" with the Returning Officer.".

#### **Section 10 Amended**

9. Subsection 10(5) is amended by striking out "(3.1)" and substituting "(3)".

#### **Section 10.1 Amended**

10. Section 10.1 is amended by adding "For greater certainty, a deposit shall not be returned unless all filings required by this Bylaw are complete, accurate and filed on time." after "provisions of this Bylaw.".

#### **Section 13 Amended**

11. Subsection 13(3) is amended by adding "and statutory boards" after "City's controlled corporations".

#### **Section 16 Amended**

12. Subsection 16(1) is amended by striking out "in writing".

#### **Section 25 Amended**

13. Section 25 is repealed and replaced with the following:

#### "Disqualification from Office

25. In addition to the penalties set out in Section 24, if a candidate who is elected contravenes any provision of this Bylaw, Part VIII of *The Cities Act* shall apply."

#### Schedule "A" Amended

14. Schedule "A" is repealed and the schedule marked as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is substituted.

#### Schedule "B" Amended

15. Schedule "B" is repealed and the schedule marked as Schedule "B" to this Bylaw is substituted.

#### Schedule "C" Amended

16. Schedule "C" is repealed and the schedule marked as Schedule "C" to this Bylaw is substituted.

#### Schedule "D" Amended

17. Schedule "D" is repealed and the schedule marked as Schedule "D" to this Bylaw is substituted.

#### New Schedule "F"

18. The Schedule marked as Schedule "E" to this Bylaw is added after Schedule "E".

#### New Schedule "G"

19. The Schedule marked as Schedule "F" to this Bylaw is added after Schedule "F".

#### **New Table of Contents**

20. The Schedule marked as Schedule "G" to this Bylaw is added after the Title page of Bylaw No. 8491.

#### **Coming into Force**

21. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
