Appendix 1 Masking Approaches on Public Transit in Canada

Vancouver

• Masks are welcome while onboard bus, SkyTrain, SeaBus and West Coast Experess. Masks are mandatory on HandyDart services

Edmonton

• Face masks on transit and in transit spaces are required under the City's Temporary Transit Facilities Face Mask Bylaw. This bylaw aligns with the mandatory mask requirements put in place by the <u>Government of Alberta</u> to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Calgary

• Face coverings are required while using Calgary Transit. Required under the mandatory mask requirements <u>Government of Alberta</u>.

Regina

• Effective February 28th, in alignment with the provincial health orders, masks are no longer required in City facilities or on Regina Transit, but are strongly encouraged.

Winnipeg

• Masks are strongly encouraged on Winnipeg Transit.

<u>Toronto</u>

• Masks are mandatory when travelling on TTC. The TTC will not be enforcing the use of masks. Required under the mandatory mask requirements by <u>Government of Ontario</u>.

<u>Ottawa</u>

• Masks are required when travelling on Ottawa Transit. Required under the mandatory mask requirements by <u>Government of Ontario</u>.

Montreal

• Masks are required. Required under the mandatory mask requirements by <u>Government of</u> <u>Quebec.</u>

Moncton

• Masks are not required.
