**Re: Civic Naming Committee Potential Shakamohtaa Street Naming**  
**(File No. CK. 6310-1)**

Please consider the following at your meeting scheduled for August 15, 2022.

At its meeting held on June 28, 2022, the Civic Naming Committee considered the attached report of the General Manager, Community Services Division, requesting the Committee's direction with respect to renaming of Shakamohtaa Street.

After deliberations, consideration of the criteria and guidelines set out in the naming policy, and consultation with the administrative resource members, the Committee resolved to recommend to the Standing Policy Committee on Planning, Development and Community Services:

1. That the Civic Naming Committee recommend to the Standing Policy Committee on Planning, Development and Community Services that this report be forwarded to City Council recommending that:
  1. The request to rename Shakamohtaa Street be approved and that Administration apply a name from the Names Master List to this street;
  2. That Administration work with the Métis community to identify an appropriate name to recommend for addition to the Names Master List and subsequent application to a new street; and
2. That Administration continue discussions with the Métis community through the Legacy Review project to identify naming opportunities that represent the diversity of Saskatoon.
