

Street Name Change from Shakamohtaa Street to taskamanwa Street

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9843, *A bylaw of the City of Saskatoon to change the name of a certain street in the City of Saskatoon as shown on Plan No. 102367920* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to change the name of Shakamohtaa Street.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1) That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9843, *A bylaw of the City of Saskatoon to change the name of a certain street in the City of Saskatoon as shown on Plan No. 102367920*; and
- 2) That all proper officers of the City of Saskatoon take the appropriate action to carry the said change into effect and have the registered plan affected properly amended.

BACKGROUND

At its [August 29, 2022 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services, dated June 28, 2022 and resolved:

1. That the request to rename Shakamohtaa Street be approved and that Administration apply a name from the Names Master List to this street;
2. That Administration work with the Métis community to identify an appropriate name to recommend for addition to the Names Master List and subsequent application to a new street; and
3. That the City Solicitor’s Office be directed to prepare the appropriate bylaw for the street name change.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

“taskamanwa Street” has been chosen from the Names Master List Administration as per Policy C09-008 – Naming of Civic Property and Development Areas to replace “Shakamohtaa Street”. “taskamanwa” is a Cree word meaning “shortcut” and was selected from the “technology” theme identified for use in this area of the Brighton neighbourhood. This name was initially identified for use through consultation with elders as part of the Chief Mistawasis Bridge project and has been finalized for use here.

Street Name Change from Shakamohtaa Street to taskamanwa Street

In order to change the name of Shakamohtaa Street, the registered plan will need to be changed which requires an application to Information Services Corporation. Part of this application includes the requirement of a bylaw amending the street name. In accordance with this and City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9843 for City Council's consideration.
