

BYLAW NO. 9842

The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 4)

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 4)*.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Traffic Bylaw* to implement a pilot program permitting vehicles which display a valid SGI Veteran license plate to park for free within posted time restrictions everywhere except in public parking lots, and to remove references to the hooding of parking meters which is no longer done.

Bylaw No. 7200 Amended

3. *The Traffic Bylaw* is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Section 12 Amended

4. (1) Subsection 12(2) is amended by adding “or” following “prohibited parking;” in clause (a).
- (2) Clause 12(2) b) is repealed.
- (3) Clause 12(2) b.1) is repealed.

Section 55.1 Amended

5. Subsection 55.1(4) is amended by striking out “56.1,”.

Section 56.1 Amended

6. Section 56.1 is repealed and the following substituted:

“Veteran Parking Program

- 56.1 (1) Subject to Subsection (2), the provisions of Subsection 55.1(1) shall not apply to a vehicle displaying a valid veteran license plate issued by Saskatchewan Government Insurance.
- (2) The driver of a vehicle mentioned in Subsection (1) shall provide payment in accordance with Subsection 55.1(1) when parked in a public parking lot.
- (3) Vehicles mentioned in Subsection (1) may not park longer than allowed by signs.”.

Section 56.2 Amended

7. Subsection 56.2(2) is repealed and the following substituted:

- “(2) Reserved parking shall be indicated on a street or in a public parking lot by the placing of traffic signs which prohibit parking.”.

Schedule No. 1 Amended

8. Section 6 of Schedule No. 1 is repealed.

Coming into Force

9. This Bylaw comes into force on November 1, 2022.
