

APPROVAL REPORT

The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 2)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9846, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 2)* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to expand the Varsity View Residential Parking Program Zone.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9846, *The Residential Parking Program Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 2)*.

BACKGROUND

At its [September 26, 2022 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services dated September 6, 2022 and resolved:
