## **BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS**

AUTHORITY Established: Bylaw No. 5728 - November 28, 1977 and The Police Act, 174 and as amended by Bylaw No. 6958 – September 12, 1988. Updated: Bylaw No. 7531 – February 5, 1996; and as amended by Bylaws 8019 – April 2, 2001; 8084 – December 17, 2001, 8261 – December 1, 2003, and 9460 – January 1,2018 PURPOSE To provide policing service to maintain a reasonable standard of law enforcement and to provide adequate and reasonable facilities required. COMPOSITION Total Membership 7 Appointed by Council 6 His Worship the Mayor; Two Members of Council; and Four members chosen from the general public. MANDATE The Board shall have the responsibilities set out in The Police Act, 1990. REPORTING Independent except for budgetary requirements. QUALIFICATIONS Understanding of the distinction between the strategic and policy setting role of the Board and the operational responsibilities of the Chief: Capability to give leadership to the development of the Board and the Police Service: • Commitment to the vision, mission, values and strategic goals of the Board: • Ability to work as a member of a team; Respect for and tolerance of the views of others; Recognition of the time commitment and the willingness to devote the time and energy necessary to perform the role of a board member: Enthusiasm and capacity for resolving challenging issues; and • Knowledge and appreciation for First Nations and Metis Family systems and community dynamics.

QUORUM Three Board members, at least one of which must be a member of City Council and at least one of which must be a member-at-large, shall constitute quorum.

## TERM: One Year

- (1) The members of the Board, other than the Mayor, shall be appointed annually for a term of January 1 to December 31 of the year of appointment.
- (2) Council may reappoint a member of the Board for a further term.
- (3) Where a Board member who holds office as a member of Council loses office as a member of Council that Board member also loses office as a Board member.
- (4) Where a vacancy occurs on the Board, the Council, within one month of the occurrence of the vacancy, shall appoint a person to replace the former Board member for the remaining term of the former Board member.
