My name is Kyle Syverson. I live on ave. L South.

I am writing to express my dismay, and even horror, at the homelessness situation in Saskatoon currently: what was unacceptable in the summer/fall months has become grossly inhumane in these winter months.

A 45 year old man died 10 days ago, and many many others are suffering daily beyond our imagining because of lack of shelter.

I urge you to maintain the money currently committed in your budget towards housing initiatives and the unhoused. I urge you to make a plan for that money, and for more monies, that hopefully will be allocated for housing concerns.

Apart from the fact that people are dying from exposure, people cannot begin to cope with addictions, getting a job, parenting, etc. without having shelter.
