Dear Mayor / City Councillors,

It is my understanding that these recommendations are being considered during the budget meeting starting on November 28, 2022:

- 1) A new mill rate contribution of \$100,000 and a capital contribution of \$300,000 toward the Saskatoon Attainable Housing Program.
- 2) A new capital project of \$245,000 for the preparation of the new Housing Strategy.
- 3) That the Administration bring forward funding source options at the time this matter is at Budget deliberations.

As a citizen of Saskatoon, I want you to know **I support** these recommendations because there are **so many people struggling to get by without access to adequate housing**.

Regina has a **city bus** that people can warm up in from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
