The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 5)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9847, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 5)* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to accommodate free parking on the day designated by the City in lieu of a holiday when that holiday falls on a Saturday or a Sunday.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9847, The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 5).

BACKGROUND

At its <u>September 26, 2022 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated September 6, 2022, and resolved:

- That the Traffic Bylaw be amended to accommodate free parking, as outlined in Option 2 - Traffic Bylaw Amendments in the report of the General Manager, Community Services dated September 6, 2022; and
- 2. That the City Solicitor be instructed to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments.
