

APPROVAL REPORT

The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9853, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to change the speed limit on portions of Neault Road and 22nd Street.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9853, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)*.

BACKGROUND

At its [September 26, 2022 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated September 6, 2022, and resolved:

1. That the speed limit on 22nd Street from Neault Road to a point 200 metres west of Neault Road be reduced from 80 km/h to 60 km/h;
2. That the speed limit on Neault Road from a point 210 metres north of 22nd Street to a point 500 metres north of 33rd Street be reduced from 90 km/h to 70 km/h; and
3. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw, effective January 1, 2023.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9853, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)* for City Council’s consideration.
