Comments:

I'm writing to encourage the City of Saskatoon to secure funding for housing initiatives at the November 28th budget meeting. I lived in Saskatoon for many years, and now live rurally - near the city - still involved in Saskatoon community organizing. It is my understanding that some recommendations regarding housing and homelessness are being considered during the budget meeting starting on November 28, 2022. I am in favour of all three recommendations being put forward and urge you to vote yes on them.

Being that I live rurally, I am also aware of the province-wide need for housing initiatives. There is no excuse for the

tragic freezing deaths that have happened already this year, and it is clearly a direct result of the lack of housing and shelter options for people.

At your budget meeting, please consider focusing on urgent actions the city could take to prevent freezing deaths this year. We need to focus on the current crisis we are in, and act acutely in order to ensure no more deaths occur in the province. Think about our community members who we have already lost to the homelessness crisis, and please stand up for future lives who might be at risk. We have a long winter ahead of us, and I urge you to prioritize securing shelters and housing initiatives to protect the lives of Saskatchewan community members.
