# The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2022

### **ISSUE**

This report submits Bylaw No. 9859, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2022* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to increase the term of appointment for members of the Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners from one year to two years.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9859, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Amendment Bylaw, 2022.* 

#### BACKGROUND

At its October 31, 2022 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered a report of City Clerk titled "Term of Appointment – Board of Police Commissioners" and resolved:

- 1. That appointments made to the Board of Police Commissioners term be a two-year term confirmed annually, effective for January 2023;
- 2. That the Terms of Reference for the Board of Police Commissioners be updated accordingly to reflect the change of term; and
- 3. That the City Solicitor be instructed to bring forward the appropriate amendments to Bylaw No. 7531, *The Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners Bylaw*.
