Comments:

Mr. Mayor and Members of Council,

Councillor Randy Donauer suggested that we submit a letter noting our concerns regarding the matter of noxious odors in the Silverwood neighbourhood.

This past fall we became aware of an increasingly pervasive smell on many days and nights in our neighbourhood - Silverwood - and contacted councillor Donauer for his input and response. At the time we described it as fishy/ rendering plant odour and smelling something very similar (our reference point was growing up in Ontario and driving through Rothsay, Ontario with rolled up windows). We noted that it was not the more common smell of our nearby sewage plant which occasionally makes things unpleasant.

Imagine our surprise to receive Randy's response regarding the existence of a rendering plant (the nose knows) in the industrial area to the west of Silverwood. We won't question the thinking behind allowing that particular kind of industry into an urban setting (and upwind of the neighbourhood) but would encourage Council to pursue all reasonable avenues to limit their emissions and halt any expansion of their capacity.
