# The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)

## **ISSUE**

This report submits Bylaw No. 9853, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6)* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to change the speed limit on portions of Neault Road and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9853, The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 6).

#### BACKGROUND

At its <u>September 26, 2022 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated September 6, 2022, and resolved:

- 1. That the speed limit on 22<sup>nd</sup> Street from Neault Road to a point 200 metres west of Neault Road be reduced from 80 km/h to 60 km/h:
- 2. That the speed limit on Neault Road from a point 210 metres north of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to a point 500 metres north of 33<sup>rd</sup> Street be reduced from 90 km/h to 70 km/h; and
- 3. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw, effective January 1, 2023.

## **DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS**

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9853, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw*, 2022 (No. 6) for City Council's consideration.
