The Waterworks and Sewer Use Amendment Bylaws

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9870, *The Waterworks Amendment Bylaw, 2023* and Bylaw No. 9871, *The Sewer Use Amendment Bylaw, 2023* ("Bylaws") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaws amend *The Waterworks Bylaw, 1996* to include a process that owners of property are required to follow to decommission unused water service connections and amend both *The Waterworks Bylaw, 1996* and *The Sewer Use Bylaw, 2017* to clarify how multi-unit residential properties are charged.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9870, *The Waterworks Amendment Bylaw, 2023* and Bylaw No. 9871, *The Sewer Use Amendment Bylaw, 2023*.

BACKGROUND

At its <u>December 19, 2022 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Utilities and Environment dated December 5, 2022, and resolved:

- 1. That the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7567, *The Waterworks Bylaw, 1996*, and Bylaw No. 9466, *The Sewer Use Bylaw, 2017*, as outlined in the December 5, 2022 report of the General Manager, Utilities and Environment, be approved; and
- 2. That the City Solicitor be requested to make the necessary amendments to Bylaw No. 7567, *The Waterworks Bylaw*, 1996, and Bylaw No. 9466, *The Sewer Use Bylaw*, 2017.
